

HOW OFTEN SHOULD I USE HUNTERCATH®

1. Wash hands thoroughly using soap and water or use a wet wipe or cleansing gel.

This depends on how much fluid you drink but most people need to empty their bladder every 4-6 hours when they are awake.

2. Open the HunterCath® packaging.

POTENTIAL SIDE EFFECTS

3. Adopt the position that you find most comfortable in order to catheterise.

A small amount of blood in the urine may occur, especially in the beginning due to irritation of the mucous membrane of the urethra.

4. Visually inspect the catheter for any damage and use it immediately.

CONTACT YOUR DOCTOR

5. Slowly and carefully insert the catheter as taught by your healthcare professional.

Contact your doctor if you experience symptoms of a urinary tract infection:

6. Once the bladder is empty slowly remove the catheter.

Fever
Discomfort or pain when urinating
Frequent need to urinate
Blood in the urine

- 7. After use put the catheter back into the packaging before disposing of responsibly.
- 8. Wash hands again with soap and water or use a wet wipe or cleansing gel.

Sterilisation: Ethylene Oxine (EtO).

Manufactured using DEHP FREE PVC.

Use HunterCath® only as prescribed by a doctor and trained by a Health professional.

Store HunterCath® in dry and cool conditions and protected from sunlight.
