A garment consisting of 10% Elastane (lycra) and 90% Polyamide (Nylon).

### 4. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES:

Polymeric fibres, chemically inert.

### 5. HEALTH HAZARD:

No health hazard is anticipated during normal handling of these products. Stop using product if skin sensitisation occurs.
